PARKING

Hotel valet parking at the hotel and it is \$49 overnight, per night, with in/out privileges.

Self parking next door at the Drake Towers with attendant parking is \$35 overnight per night, with no in/out privileges.

ROOM RATE

The Drake Traditional room rate is \$229 per night. This rate is offered 3 days before and 3 days after the conference dates, based on room and rate availability. The sooner you book your hotel reservations, the better your chances of having rooms available. The AIPAGIA room block will be released on August 22. A credit card is required to guarantee one night at the time you make your reservations. A 72-hour cancellation notice is required prior to your arrival date to avoid being charged one (1) night room and tax.

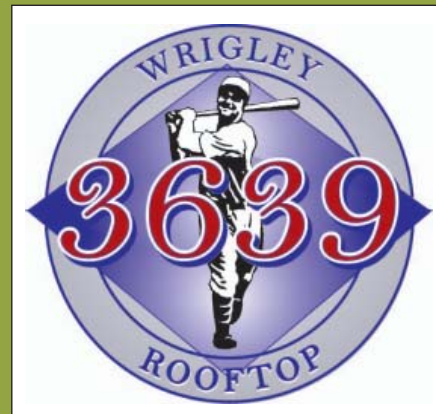
