HISTORY

Following an extensive \$70 million modernization, Riviera Resort & Spa – a legendary 24-acre property that was once a playground for the likes of Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Sammy Davis, Jr. and Elvis Presley – reopened to the public in October 2008.

Over the last 50 years, the Riviera has welcomed dozens of Hollywood types and politicians, and has been the site of events ranging from Urban Network Magazine's Annual Power Jam to the first diplomatic meeting between the U.S. and Mexico in 1964. "Palm Springs Weekend," starring Troy Donahue and Connie Stevens, was filmed here in 1963, and throughout the '60s and '70s, the property became a Mecca for film industry movers and shakers. In later years, the resort languished into obscurity. Noble House purchased the property in 2006 and promptly embarked on an ambitious revitalization project, aimed at restoring the property to its former glory.

The landmark property originally opened to much fanfare in 1958, and during its 1960's heyday, was billed "Palm Springs' largest and most famous resort." The new Riviera offers a luxurious spa, two sparkling swimming pools, signature fine dining and entertainment, lushly-landscaped gardens with intimate courtyards anchored by fire pits.

The resort is located at the foot of the spectacular San Jacinto Mountains in the heart of old Palm Springs. The historic downtown hub features shopping, dining, entertainment and cultural amenities extraordinaire. Aside from the area's renowned golfing and shopping, Riviera Resort & Spa is minutes away from enjoying city tours of celebrity homes, the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, the Palm Springs Art Museum, eco-tours of Joshua Tree National Park and the San Andreas Fault, and the McCallum Theatre for the Performing Arts.
